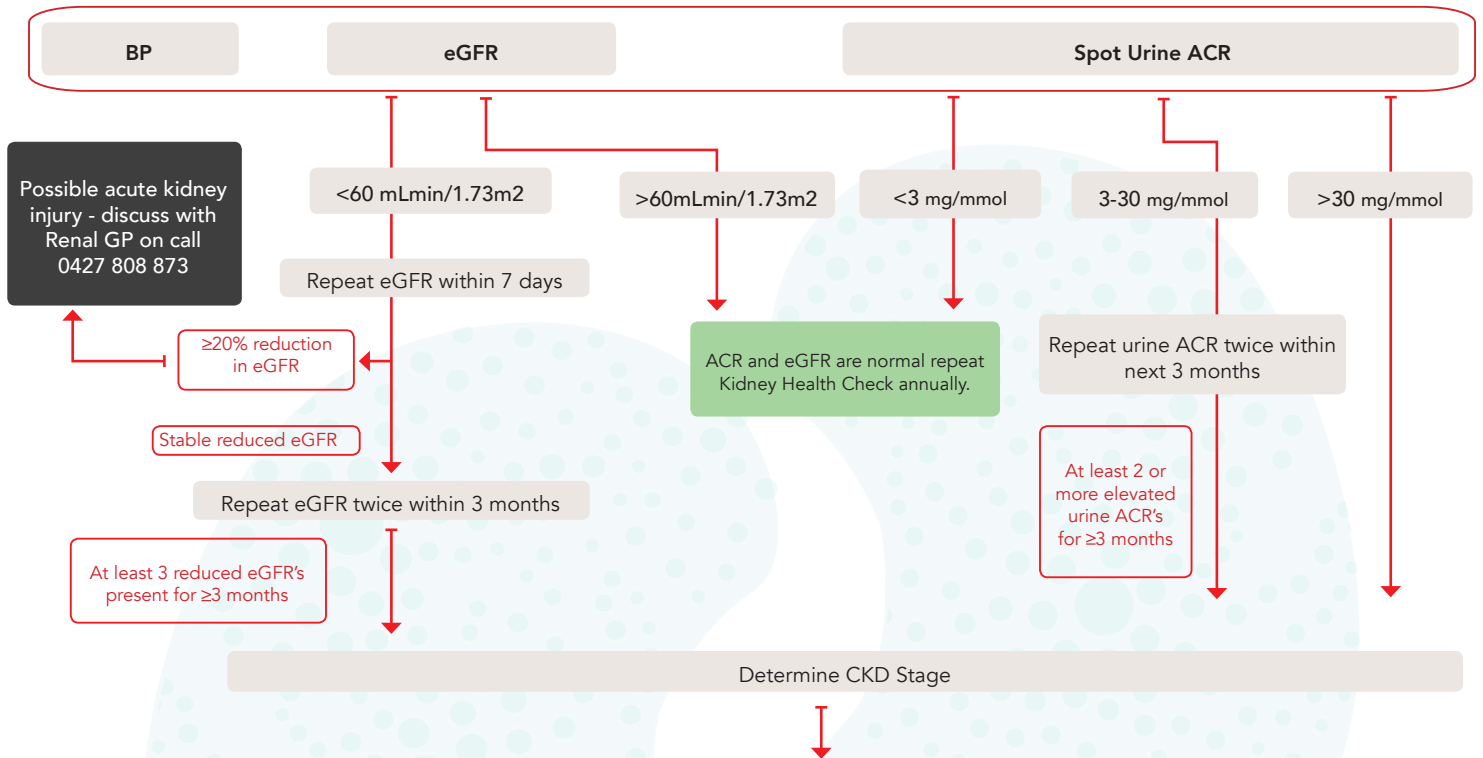


# DIAGNOSTIC PATHWAY FOR CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE IN THE KIMBERLEY

**Complete Kidney Health Check annually for people with any following indications and who are not known to have CKD.**

- Diabetes
- Hypertension
- Established cardiovascular disease
- Family history of kidney failure

- Obesity
- Smoking
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander origin aged  $\geq 15$  years
- Acute Kidney Injury
- Use of nephrotoxic drugs
